Gardening Tips

- Pinch faded blossoms from Crepe Myrtles but do not prune branches.
- Hummingbird feeders should be cleaned and filled with fresh sugar water every 3-4 days.
- Mulch, Mulch, Mulch...Mulching benefits beds by reducing weed growth, guarding roots against heat stress and water evaporation.
- Feed Plumeria a high phosphorus fertilizer. Hibiscus likes low phosphorus.
- Keep rose beds clean of fallen leaf and flower litter to reduce black spot.
