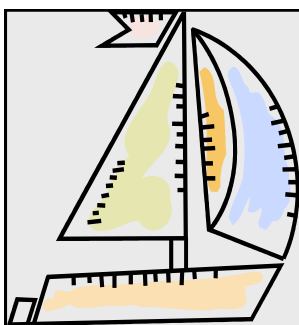

AUGUST GARDENING TIPS

- Plumeria likes a high phosphorus fertilizer-Hibiscus likes low phosphorus
- Thin Camellia buds to one per cluster for larger blooms
- Keep Rose beds clean to reduce black spot
- Pinch faded blossoms from Crepe Myrtles but do not prune branches
- Hummingbird feeders should be cleaned and refilled with fresh sugar water every 3-4 days. To make your own add nectar- Add 1 cup sugar to 4 cups water. Boil 1-2 minutes. Store in refrigerator.
- Prepare fall gardens this month, keeping in mind that a well-prepared bed is essential for good results
- Mulch guards against heat stress and water evaporation

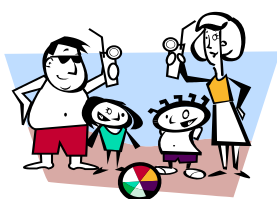
