Please take time to bag or mulch yard/leaves/needles and dispose of cut tree branches during our 4th Monday heavy trash collection. The surface street drains and pond system direct excess water away from our homes and help protect from standing water and flooding. Our street surface drains need to stay clear to carry excess water to our ponds and lake.

The ponds and the lake do not need additional sediment deposits, and naturally receive plenty decomposing material.
