On Thursday, February 28, members of PAWC are planning a trip to The Museum of Fine Arts, Houston to view the exhibit **PORTRAIT OF SPAIN: MASTERPIECES FROM THE PRADO**.

Houston is one of only two cities in the world to have this exhibit visit. Brisbane, Australia is the other. The exhibit shows the development of painting in Spain from the 16th through the 19th centuries. We will see changes in society, culture, politics and religion. Some of the artists included are Goya, El Greco, Murillo, Velazquez, as well as some European artists who influenced art in Spain such as Rubens, Titan and Tielpolo.

We will carpool, leaving the Marina parking lot at 9 am, touring at 10:30, then have lunch in the museum coffee shop (good soups, salads, sandwiches and more; reasonable priced).

COST: \$15 for seniors; optional headphones for \$5; gas contribution to your driver; and lunch. It may be a bit less because general admission on Thursday has an underwriter, but the exhibit is our main cost.
