POOL RULES & HOURS

- No swimming alone-No lifeguards on duty
- No animals are allowed in pools or on the deck
- No breakable containers allowed
- No running or diving
- An adult must accompany children under 12
- Pools are CLOSED on Mondays for maintenance
- Pools open at 8 AM for adult swim ONLY until 10 AM
- Pools are OPEN to all property owners Tuesday through Sunday- 10 AM to 9 PM

GARDENING TIPS FOR JULY

- Keep applying small doses of water soluble fertilizer to roses every 4-6 weeks... deadhead those faded blooms.
- Pecans require tons of water to assure proper kernel development
- If you must plant container grown trees and shrubs during the hot summer months, provide deep, regular irrigation.
- Sow seeds of snapdragon, dianthus, pansies, and other cool-season flowers in flats inside for transplanting outside during mid-to-late fall.
- Spray insecticides during early morning or late evening to avoid burning leaves...not during the heat of the day.
- Add a few drops of liquid detergent to the water when mixing fire ant insecticides...it speeds up the action of the insecticide.
- Some perennials go into dormancy now through August...be patient.
- Plant cantaloupe, squash, watermelon, okra, lima pole beans, southern peas
- When repotting cactus, make a sling of twisted newspaper to lift the plant from one pot to the other.
- Soak used clay pots in a 10% bleach solution (1 part bleach and 9 parts water) and rinse well before reuse...A wire brush will remove white mineral deposits
- As your Spring annuals fade, plant more summer annuals like portulaca, vinca, cosmos and cleome...Plant begonias in shady beds and hanging baskets.
- Stop pinching back mums and poinsettias to allow plants to fill out and flower properly.
