

GARDENING TIPS FOR JULY

- Keep applying small doses of water soluble fertilizer to roses every 4-6 weeks... Deadhead those faded blooms.
- Stop pinching back mums and poinsettias to allow plants to "fill out" and flower properly.
- Some perennials go into dormancy now through August... be patient
- If you must plant container-grown trees and shrubs during the hot summer months, provide deep, regular irrigation
