## HAPPY JULY 4

As you may know, there was some concern about last year's 4th of July with noise, mess, and crowding around the Pegasus boat ramp area. To help make this a good event for all, we are taking a few precautions this year.

The Pegasus Boat ramp and parking lot will be closed to boat launch and vehicle traffic July 3-4, giving our residents space to gather in the parking lot.

The Pegasus waterfront parking lot will be sectioned off near the street for golf cart parking ONLY. No 4 wheelers or UTA vehicles. We want to separate people areas from golf cart parking making it a bit easier to get around the parking lot. Please do not park on the grass. Please park cars at the Community Center. Thank you for your cooperation.

Marina and Park boat launch will be open, and tailored boats will be directed to Marina Loop. We will provide notice to guests arriving with tailored boats, directing them to Section 7 Marina.

Please be courteous to our neighbors...no loud public/private gatherings or fireworks after 10 PM. Residents with trauma disabilities, parents with small children, and pet owners request your cooperation!

We have a crew scheduled to clean up parking at both Pegasus waterfront parking and Marina and Park lot on July 4, as Republic trucks will be running that day. The area should be cleaned up by the time residents' return to the area.

Boat launch at Marina and Park (Marina Loop) only. Pools will be open all weekend (closed on Tuesday for cleaning).

No alcohol in fenced pool area.

No cooking of any kind in the fenced pool area.

Fireworks will wrap up early. Please respect residents...no large and noisy gatherings after 11 PM over the weekend.
