HURRICANE EMERGENCY HELPFUL TIPS

BE Prepared:

- Copy of all important documents and numbers, (don't forget to backup your home computer)
- Have a friend or family member that does not live in the same area to be the person all family members call to give location and contact information to if you have to evacuate.
- Keep a list of the medicine you take and your doctors contact info with you.
- Have a battery operated radio with extra batteries.
- If you have special needs, check with your local city or county about registering for assistance in advance.
- Pets-medicine and food
- Enough food, water and medicine for 3 days per person.

Prepare your home before you leave:

- Turn off or unplug as many of your electronics items you can.
- Turn off GAS and Water if needed.
- Take food from your refrigerator with you
- Start NOW using clean milk jugs to freeze water. This will help keep your freezer cold if you lose power or need water.
- Remove all hanging baskets or loose items from your yard or porches so they will not blow into your windows.
- Keep your trees trimmed all year long.
- Put all trash cans and recycling bins in the garage.
- Check the weather channel for warning and listen to the officials on when and what you should do.
