JUNE GARDENING TIPS

- Fertilize established annuals and perennials with a high nitrogen/low phosphorus fertilizer such as 15-5-10.
- Fertilize pecan trees with 1 lb. of 15-5-10 fertilizer per inch of trunk diameter.
- Treat lawns for white grubs now through early August with an approved insecticide... If soil is dry, water deeply 2-3 days before application.
- Watch out for chinch bugs in lawns... They begin in hot spots near walks and drives... Control measures should be started as soon as damage is first noticed.
