Republic Services will always pick up:

- Limbs that are no more than 4' long & tied in bundles weighing no more than 50 lbs.
- Appliances
- Furniture
- Grills without propane tanks
- TV's that weigh less than 50 lbs.

Republic Services will not pick up:

- Construction debris (lumber, etc.)
- Carpet
- Sheetrock
- Fencing
- Tires
- Paint
- Concrete
- Chemicals
