The Point Aquarius Women's Club is delighted to announce that we will award two \$1000 education scholarships, \$500 each semester for each recipient, for the 2016-2017 academic year.

Criteria include:

- Applicant must be a permanent resident of the Point Aquarius subdivision.
- The application is open to high school seniors, college students, and adults returning to school for continuing/professional/technical educational programs.
- The scholarships must be used at a U.S. Institution on U.S. soil.

There are no age or financial restrictions. The application packet may be picked up at the Point Aquarius POA Office beginning Tuesday, March 1, 2016. The DEADLINE for submission of the completed packet is 5PM, Friday, April 15, 2016.

Maintenance Fees:

If you are paying your fee monthly, your first payment was due Jan. 1, 2016. Monthly payments are due in advance on the first day of every month.

- Dirt bikes, four wheelers and motorcycles are not allowed on vacant lots or common areas.
- There is no parking allowed on your lawn, on vacant lots, or in common areas.
- No parking on the street in Sections 1, 2, 3, 6, and 10.
- In Sections 5, 7, 8, 9 & 1R parking on the street is allowed but only short term parking (up to 10 hours).
- If you do not know what sections your property is in please contact the POA office to find out.
- All pets must be on a leash. If your pet defecates on someone's property or in the common area, you are to pick it up and dispose of it at your home.
- Spring is here! It's time to tidy up the exterior of your property. Trim trees & shrubs, remove pine needles from your roof, pressure wash your home, spruce up your flower beds, etc.
- If you receive a deed violation notice, please do not ignore it. Call the POA office to let us know when you will take care of the violations.
