NEW PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

A total update of the children's playground is partially completed with the installation of a GameTime playscape system and new swing set. The system is a collection of play components complete with ladders, slides, sound elements and overhead bars. It is especially designed for children aged 5 to 12 years. The system was installed on a cushion of mulch and is an area that is well-shaded by trees.

The new equipment was partially funded with contribution from community members and organizations. A collection was taken up at the annual POA Holiday party. In March, the Point Aquarius Women's Club voted to donate \$1000 to the playground fund. As the playscape system can be expanded, the POA will continue to accept contributions to the playground fund for future enhancements to this community amenity for our children and grandchildren.
