POA PROJECTS

The mulch trail behind the POA office is under repair. Over the years, the trail elevation has fallen below surface grade. When it rains, downhill water runoff is channeled along the trail toward the office and parking lot, causing erosion and standing water near the building.

The trail is raised to direct water away from the building toward the pond near Natures Trail, and provide a solid trail surface. We added fast growing shrubs along the North property line, and around the building. The improvements will be complete this week.

The sprinkler installation between the Gate and FM 1097 will begin this month. This project should be completed in less than 10 days. Single lane closures may happen throughout the day, as sprinkler lines are installed at the sides of the road and in medians.
