## MAY GARDENING TIPS

- Prune roses after blooming cycle is completed.
- Follow amaryllis blooming cycle with fertilizer.
- Check for spider mites and white flies on hibiscus. Early treatment will protect against infestation.
- For hot spots, try Lantana, Cosmos, Celocia, Portulaca and copper plant. They perform well with little care.
- Fertilize your lawn if you have not already done so.

If you are trimming your own trees (or shrubs) or having them trimmed by a professional, please do not stack them in vacant lots or common areas.

Street Curb & Gutters  
Keep this area free of weeds, dirt and debris to improve drainage.

Parking On The Streets  
Willis ISD and Emergency vehicles have reported not being able to get to their destinations in the neighborhood. Please respect your neighbors and do not park in the street or commons or vacant lots or on the grass.

Section 1 Common Area Project
