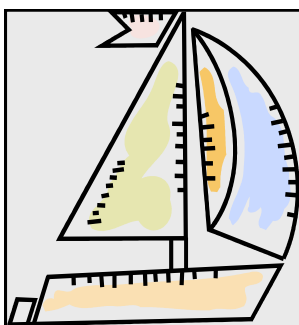

- Fertilize lawns for the last time this year. Use a 3-1-2 or 2-1-2 ratio fertilizer.
- This is a good time to plant trees.
- Apply blood meal to pansy beds and work into top 6 inches of soil before setting out transplants.
