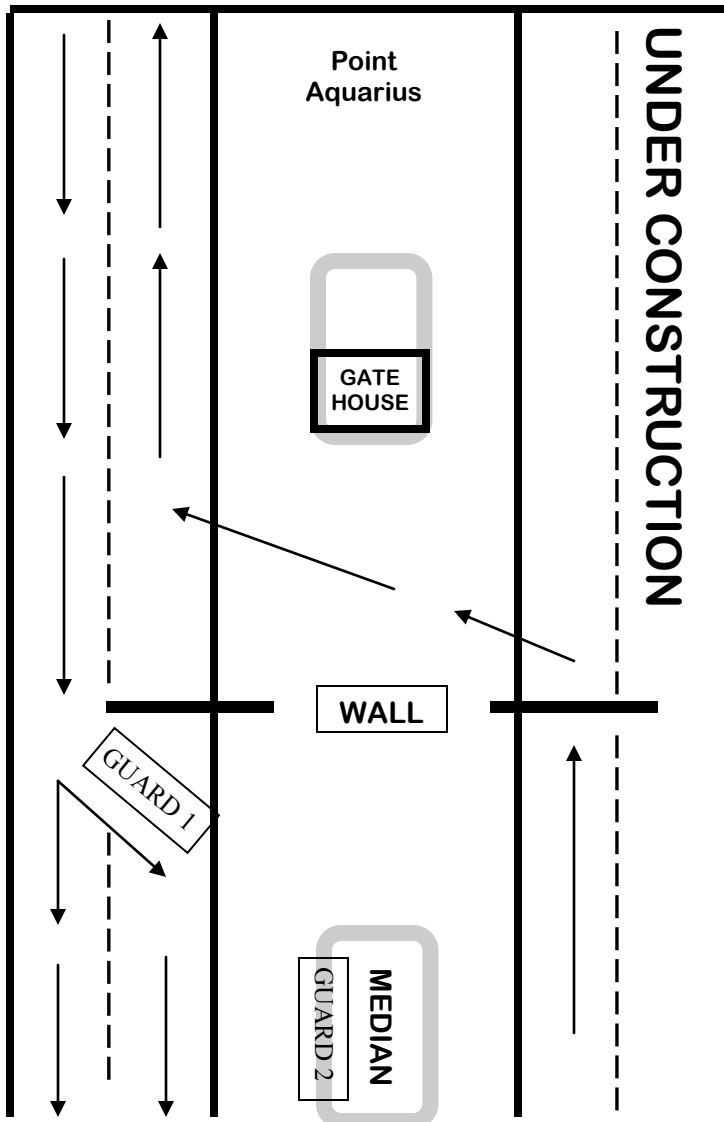


## Farther Down The Road More Traveled!



The Next phase of the road construction project is scheduled to begin the **LAST WEEK OF MARCH / FIRST OF APRIL**. The outbound boulevard of Point Aquarius will be closed. This project will take approximately six weeks to complete depending on weather conditions. - Residents, please secure a decal to decrease delays at the gate.;
- When exiting, please consider turning right only during busy times of day.;
- Please, make sure to notify the guards at the gate house of guest(s).;
- Please, consider running optional errands during less busy times of day.

**GUARD 1:** The first guard/volunteer will wave in residents with decals or gate cards, contractors and/or service providers with passes. Guests and other traffic will be directed to Guard 2.

**GUARD 2:** The second guard will be a regular guard from Point Aquarius. This guard will be responsible for recording and admitting guest(s) and/or other traffic not covered by decal, gate card or pass.

All residents are encouraged to participate in the Neighborhood Watch and Safety Committee (NWSC). Several easy steps you and your family can take to participate include the following:

Get to know your neighbors.  
Be aware of your surroundings.  
Observe and report suspicious activity.

Be a good neighbor.  
Get involved in the community.

NWSC is being active and aware of what is going on in your neighborhood. If a crime or incident occurs, you are encouraged to be a good witness, observe and report incidents. While residents are encouraged to be involved in our community, there is NOT a component of our NWSC which includes a group of residents as sanctioned patrollers.

Our community, directed by the Board, uses **off-duty law enforcement officers to patrol the neighborhood** during critical times to ensure the safety of our residents. The most efficient method for our officers to obtain detailed information regarding incidents is the Incident Report Form. Residents may find the form on the Point Aquarius web site to print out copies or complete form online. <http://pointaquarius.com/committees/neighborhood-watch-committee> These reports, if entered online, enter a live database which is monitored by NWSC and the patrol officers. This database has restricted access to promote confidential collection of data directly from the observer and not by word of mouth within the community.

If you observe a crime in progress, do NOT confront, reprimand or try to detain the individual(s). Your safety is important to us, please do not intervene in a crime in progress. Please, contact the Sheriff's Department at (936) 760 – 5800. For emergencies, please call 911. The Sheriff's Department **REQUIRES** the observer report the crime to collect data first hand. Talk with the Sheriff's deputy/dispatcher about reporting anonymously if you are concerned about retaliation. The NWSC will not support and/or defend any actions of residents acting without authorization of NWSC, Board or Directors or Property Owners Association. Residents acting without authorization may be subject to liability for any criminal and/or civil damages which may result from his/her actions. Residents who feel inappropriately approached, confronted and/or harassed are encouraged to complete an incident report.

### **GateKey Update**

The Board of Directors approved a new web based software system to manage the guest list(s) of residents at the gate house.
