PAWC RECIPES

CORNBREAD SALAD

- 1 1 oz. package Hidden Valley Ranch Dry Salad Dressing Mix
- 1 C sour cream
- 1 C mayonnaise
- 1 Tblsp lemon juice
- 1 pan corn bread (crumbled)
- 2 cans pinto beans (drained)
- 2 cans whole kernel corn (drained)
- 3 large tomatoes, chopped
- 1/2 C chopped green pepper
- 1/2 C chopped green onions
- 2 C shredded cheddar cheese
- 10 slices bacon, cooked & crumbled

Combine mayonnaise, sour cream, salad dressing mix & lemon juice. Set aside. Place half of crumbled corn bread in bottom of large serving bowl. Top with half of beans, corn, onions, peppers, tomatoes, cheese, bacon and dressing.

Repeat layers using remaining ingredients. Cover and chill 2-3 hours before serving.
