Thanks to the candidates who volunteered to serve as At-large members of the POA Directors and ACC. We had excellent neighborhood participation in the election.

Ken Kubecka and the committee for the nominations and elections, Brenda Davis, Carol Shannon and Earline Stash, did a great job making the election process run smoothly. The Annual Meeting, Saturday, April 28 highlighted community projects completed in 2017-2018. The projects included the Section 7 Marina and Park dock work, improvements in Dry and Community Storage, and bulkhead improvement on the Lake and along Point Aquarius Blvd.

Recreational amenity improvements were resurfaced courts, lighting upgrades and improved accessibility to restroom at Pegasus pool. Community watershed to the Lake had spillway improvements and fountain additions. PAWC worked with the Board, purchasing the Gemini fountain. The Section 1 drainage project continues, along with ongoing road repair/replacement.

The ACC report 80 projects were approved the ACC and only 3 rejections. New home builds have slowed markedly as fewer lots are available. There were 5 requests for new homes and 2 are still under construction.
