FLAG DAY

THURSDAY, JUNE 14

In the United States, Flag Day is celebrated on June 14. It commemorates the adoption of the flag of the United States on June 14, 1777.

When the US flag is displayed other than from a staff, it should be displayed flat or suspended so that its folds fall free.

When the US flag is displayed projecting from a building, the union of the flag should be placed at the peak of the building.

Never let the flag touch anything beneath it: ground, floor, water, merchandise.

It's considered respectful to have a constant light shining on the flag at night.

When the flag is worn out or otherwise no longer a fitting emblem for display, it should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferably by burning.

When displayed with another flag against a wall from closed staffs, the US flag should be on its own right (so that when you look at the flags, you see the US flag on the left), and the US flag's staff should be in front of the staff of the other flag.
