The routine is always a bit different each day, but nothing so complicated as to be intimidating and there are no "exercise police". AUGUST GARDENING TIPS

- Keep rose beds clean of fallen leaf and flower litter to reduce black spot
- Pinch faded blossoms from crepe myrtles but do not prune branches
- Leave 3 foot collar around the base of trees so you won't nick them with mowers or string weeders
- Hummingbird feeders should be cleaned and filled with fresh sugar water every 3-4 days
- Mulch, mulch, mulch. Mulching Benefits beds by reducing weed growth, guarding roots against heat stress and water evaporation.
- Try cape honeysuckle, hame-lia, firecracker, cypress vine or pineapple sage to attract butterflies and hummingbirds
- Plumeria like a high phosphorus fertilizer. Hibiscus likes low phosphorus.
- Thin camellia buds to one per cluster for larger flowers.
- Try a Meyer lemon in a container for extremely fragrant blooms and attractive fruit almost year round.
