The vital force of labor added materially to the highest standard of living and greatest production of and the the world has ever known and has brought us closer to the re-alization of our traditional ideals of economic and political democracy. It is appropriate, therefore, that the nation pays tribute on Labor Day to the creator of so much of the nation's strength, freedom, and leadership, the American workers.
