PAWC SCHOLARSHIPS

The Point Aquarius Women's Club is delighted to announce they will award two \$1,000 educational scholarships, \$500 each semester for each recipient, for the 2019-2020 academic year.

Criteria include:

- Applicant must be a permanent resident of Point Aquarius subdivision, Willis, Texas.
- 2. Applicant must provide copy of a current Texas State driver's license or State issued OD that matches the Point Aquarius address listed on the application.
- 3. Scholarship monies must be applied toward a U.S. Institution on US. Soil.

The application process is open to high school seniors, current college students, or for continuing/professional/technical education programs.

There is no age or financial restriction. The application packet may be picked up at the Point Aquarius POA office beginning Friday, March 1, 2019. The DEADLINE for submission of the complete packet is Monday, April 1, 2019, so don't delay.

The second semester scholarship award is contingent upon the student providing proof of passing grades for semester one and showing enrollment for continuing their class(es) for semester two.

The scholarship committee comprised of Mary Jane Crowe, Kathy Brown, Carol Lorch, and Diane Crowe will be arranging interviews in the near future for those applicants who have completed all requirements for the scholarship application. Winners will be announced by May 1, 2019.
