Stop by and rummage through household goods (bric-a-brac, kitchen appliances, lamps, jewelry, accessories, and many more treasures).

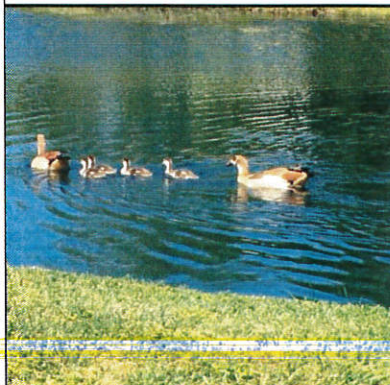
