THE REAL ID ACT

Take a look at your driver's license. If it does not have a gold star in the upper right corner, your license is not REAL ID compliant. You will not be able to take a domestic commercial flight any time after Oct. 1, 2020.

The Real ID Act was passed in 2005 in response to the 9/11 terrorist attacks.

To obtain your new card, go to a DPS driver license office with proof of identity, state residency, US citizenship or lawful presence in the US and obtain a READ ID license or ID card.

Don't wait too long to start the process.

If your license expires before Oct. 1, 2020, just renew your license like normal and you will get your Gold Star.

- The Fourth of July was not declared a federal holiday until 1938.
- The first White House Forth of July party was held in 1804.

- The Declaration of Independence was a justification for a revolt against the British which included a list of charges against the British king.
- "Yankee Doodle", a popular American patriotic song, was originally sung prior to the Revolution by British military officers in mockery of the unorganized and buckskin-wearing "Yankees".
- The "Star Spangled Banner" was written by Francis Scott Key and was originally a poem stemming from his observations in 1814 concerning the British attack on Baltimore's Fort McHenry during the War of 1812. It was later put to music, though not decreed the official national anthem until 1931.
