POINT AQUARIUS TREES

Point Aquarius adopted 50 new trees Dec. 7, 2019. Roy and Liz Kessler, along with a large group of volunteers from the Conroe Presbyterian Youth Group planted: 15 pines, 14 red oak, 9 live oak, 6 sego, 3 cedar, 2 bald cypress, 1 red maple—50 total new trees.

PAWC newsletter readers are familiar with Roy's annual tree project for Point Aquarius. Roy collects seedlings from his yard and neighborhood contributors, nurtures them in his backyard nursery for a year, then gathers the youth group to plant the trees. Roy started planting trees along Point Aquarius Boulevard several years ago, and works year round keeping the young trees healthy and happy for their first few years.

2020 Annual Assessment

Your statement shows the 2020 assessment in addition to any past due balance on your account.

There is still a \$120 discount if the assessment is paid by Jan. 31, 2020. The address on your statement is a PO Box in Arizona. Don't worry. The Arizona address is to the primary banking institution, Mutual of Omaha. Sending your payment to that address will ensure the payment is processed quickly.

If you choose to make monthly payments, they should be received the first of each month with the first due by Jan. 1, and in the amount as follows:

Sections 1-4 & 6-10: \$85 per month

Section 5A: \$100 per month (\$1020 + \$180 Operations fee)

Section 5B: \$87.09 per month (\$1020 + \$25 Operations fee)
