### NO WAKE ZONES

The San Jacinto River Authority have "no wake" zones near mari-nas and boat launches. While While public safety is the reason many of these zones also has benefits for the property owners and environment. Owners directly benefit from decreased wave energy hitting bulkheads. The constant impact wears away sediment from unprotected shoreline. Please observe No Wake zones.

#### GARDENING TIPS FOR MAY

- Plant new shrubs early before the heat arrives. Plant summer blooming perennials and annuals.
- Mulch beds to discourage weeds, keep roots cool and conserve moisture.
- Fertilize azaleas, hibiscus, and containers.
- Maintain watering on newly planted seeds and transplants.
- Keep an eye out for pests as well as beneficial insects in your vegetable garden.
- Fill bird baths and keep water fresh.
