Unfortunately, the status of the pools has not changed. We still have Swim At Your Own Risk pools, even though the Governor has allowed the pools to open, they can only operate at 25% capacity. Without life guards or pool monitors, there is no way to enforce this. Other subdivisions (April Sound, Bentwater, Seven Coves, Walden, etc.) have opened their pools because they have life guards. We understand this is frustrating for individuals and families. Still the Board has the responsibility of not just protecting the association from a virus, but also the responsibility of limiting the liability the association may be exposed to by those choosing not to follow the rules.

The POA will be looking into solutions that will allow the pools to reopen. Your will receive another update once we know what those solutions are.
