LAWN WATERING TIPS

- 1. Water only when needed.
- 2. Space watering as far apart as possible.
- 3. Moisten the full depth of the effective rooting zone of the grass (4-6").
- 4. Realize that various sections of the turn may have different water requirements.
- 5. Maintain adequate soil moisture but avoid constant surface dampness, which can promote further disease development.

The best time to water is early morning (4-6 AM) because less water is lost through evaporation.

The wind is at its lowest, and less water lost due to drift.

If your lawn slopes, you will need to watch for run-off so water will not be washed. If run-off occurs, stop sprinkling for about 1/2 hour then resume watering until run-off occurs again.
