## THANKSGIVING RECIPES

### SWEET POTATO BISCUITS

- 2 cups mashed sweet potatoes
- 4 cups flour
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons baking powder
- 2 tsp salt
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 cup (2 sticks) melted butter
- 1 1/3 cup buttermilk

Preheat oven to 375 degrees.  
Whisk flour, sugar, baking pow-  
der, salt and baking soda to-  
gether until there are no lumps.  
Make well in center of dry in-  
gredients. Combine sweet pota-  
toes, butter, and mix. Add to  
dry ingredients. Combine until  
soft dough forms. Pat/roll out  
to 1 inch thick. Cut into round  
shapes. Bake 26 minutes until  
light golden brown. Let cool.  
Makes 24.
