# PAWC SCHOLARSHIPS

The Point Aquarius Women's Club is once again delighted to announce they will award **two \$1,000 educational** scholarships, \$500 each semester for each recipient, for the 2021-22 academic year.

## Criteria include:

1.Applicant must be a permanent resident of Point Aquarius subdivision, Willis, Texas.

2.Applicant must provide copy of a current Texas State driver's license or State issued ID that matches the Point Aquarius address listed on the application.

3.Scholarship monies must be applied toward a U.S. Institution on U.S. soil. The application process is open to high school seniors, current college students, returning-to-school students, or for continuing/professional/technical education programs. There is no age or financial restriction.

The scholarship application forms are available on the Point Aquarius website at: www.pointaquarius.com beginning Monday, March 1, 2021. Interested applicants may access these forms by going to the Point Aquarius website; select the Documents tab; select Forms; and then select Scholarship Application. Applications can be submitted online back to the Point Aquarius email address at: office@pointaquarius.com. Anyone who does not have access to a computer, may stop by the POA office and request a printed copy of the application packet. Susan Hamlin, as in the past, has graciously agreed to assist the scholarship committee and applicants by providing copies for these applicants; and these applications can be returned to the POA office by the deadline date. The DEADLINE for submission of the complete packet is

Friday, April 9, 2021, so don't delay. The second semester scholarship award is contingent upon the student providing proof of passing grades for semester one and proof of enrollment for continuing their class(es) for semester two.

## CEDAR WAXWING



Recently I've been seeing flocks of cedar waxwings in our area. They are named for the waxy red tips on their secondary wing feathers, but the purpose of the waxy secretions is unknown. These crested birds have pale yellow to lemon-colored bellies and a matching band of yellow at the tip of their square tail. A black mask edged in white extends fro its bead and surrounds its eyes. The rest of the bird's plumage is gray to brown.

These birds specialize in fruiteating during the winter months. Cedar berries are the most popular food source, but other fruits are also consumed. They pluck berries while perching, hanging upside down, or briefly hovering in midair.
