Pools:

The new access controls have been installed at both pools. If you need additional key cards or want the key fob, these items will need to be purchased in the front office.

Marinas:

New gates will be installed with updated access control that will utilize your existing gate card or key fob. The marinas will no longer have a key to access them and will be accessible to those who own slips.

Front Gates:

Reminder, only ONE car can pass through the gate per opening. If the gate is up, wait for the car in front of you to pass through and for the gate to close before attempting to pass. With the updates to our systems, we are working to install long-range readers to eliminate the need to roll down your window when entering the resident's side.

All of these updates will allow us to minimize non-residents from accessing our amenities and make entering a little more efficient for our residents. Please make sure you and your family members are not opening the gates for individuals attempting to enter without a gate key or fob.

Deed Restrictions:

It is the responsibility of each resident to know and abide by the deed restrictions. There have been many violations that we are spending money to send violation letters which are clearly outlined in our deed restrictions. This is an unnecessary cost to our residents. Additionally, one of the biggest violations we are seeing is the displaying of flags that are not allowed.

Beginning August 12th, the ACC flags guidelines (ACC-Guidelines -Regs.pdf (pointaquarius.com) will be enforced and deed restriction violation letters will be sent to anyone outside of the guidelines.

If you are making any improvements to the outside of your home, you must complete a request packet (REQUEST FOR ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL COMMITTEE APPROVAL (pointaquarius.com)) and receive approval prior to making updates.
