Beginning in October 20 recycling collection with a 95-gallon recycle cart 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of the month. Please have it at the curb by 7 AM. Acceptable Recycling items:

Paper board
Aluminum Cans
Brown Paper Bags
Phone Books
Catalogs
Magazines
Newspapers
Junk Mail
Tin and steel cans
Office and school paper
Cardboard-broken down
Glass bottles and jars
Plastics #1, #2 and #3
Cereal and food boxes
Milk and orange juice cartons

Help reduce contamination. Remove food residue. Items must be empty, clean, and dry.

Unacceptable items: clothing, pizza boxes, shoes, plastic bags, Styrofoam, or any items not on the acceptable recycling items list above.
