WHITE PELICANS

One of the largest birds in North America, with a 9-foot wingspan, we see them this time of year on the lake.

They forage by swimming on the surface, dipping their bill into water and scooping up fish in their pouch.

During breeding season it does much foraging at night, locating fish by touch during frequent dipping of it's bill; by day, probably locates prey visually. They may forage cooperatively, lining up and driving fish toward shallower water.

Adult pelicans are snowy white with black flight feathers visible only when the wings are spread. A small patch of ornamental feather on the chest can become yellow in spring. Bills and legs are yellow-orange.
