PAWC SCHOLARSHIPS

The Point Aquarius Women's Club is once again delighted to announce they will award two \$1,000 educational scholarships, \$500 each semester for each recipient, for the 2022-23 academic year.

Criteria include:

- Applicant must be a permanent resident of Point Aquarius subdivision, Willis, Texas.
- 2. Applicant must provide copy of a current Texas State driver's license or State issued ID that matches the Point Aquarius address listed on the application.
- Scholarship monies must be applied toward a U.S. Institution on U.S. soil.

The application process is open to high school seniors, current college students, returning-toschool students, or for continuing/professional/technical education programs. There is no age, grade point average, or financial restriction.

The scholarship packets are available for pick up at the POA office beginning March 1, The forms are also avail 2022. able for download on the Point Aquarius website at: www.pointaquarius.com beginning Tuesday, March 1, 2022. Interested applicants may access these forms by going to the Point Aquarius website; select Documents the tab; select Forms; and then select Scholarship Application. Applications can be submitted online back to the Point Aquarius email address at:

or these applications can be returned to the POA office by the deadline date. The DEADLINE for submission of the complete packet (application form, essay and reference letters) is Thursday, March 31, 2022; so don't delay.

The second semester scholarship award is contingent upon the student providing proof of passing grades for semester one and proof of enrollment for continuing their class(es) for semester two.

If you have resident students in your household or know of any in the neighborhood, the PAWC will appreciate it if you pass this information about these scholarship opportunities along to them.
