PAWC SCHOLARSHIPS

The Point Aquarius Women's Club is once again delighted to announce they will award two \$1,000 educational scholarships, \$500 each semester for each recipient, for the 2023-24academic year.

Criteria include:

1. Applicant must be a permanent resident of Point Aquarius subdivision, Willis, Texas.
2. Applicant must provide copy of a current Texas State driver's license or State issued ID that matches the Point Aquarius address listed on the application.

3. Scholarship monies must be applied toward a U.S. Institution on U.S. soil.

The application process is open to high school seniors, current college students, returning-toschool students, or for continuing/professional/technical education programs. There is no age, grade point average, or financial restriction.

The second semester scholarship award is contingent upon the student providing proof of passing grades for semester one and proof of enrollment for continuing their class(es) for semester two.

MARCH GARDENING TIPS

March is a great month to plant shade, fruit and nut trees. Most shrubs, perennials and herb can be planted now. Plant cool-season annual flowers, such as lobelaria, snapdragons and petunias.

Warm season annual color should be planted one to two weeks after any overnight freezes. Select from a variety annuals like marigolds, impatiens, begonias, zinnia, and coleus. As we near the end of the month, watch for options to add pentas, lantana, rose, and angelonia.

Fertilize twice a year in spring fallen limbs must be cut in 4' and fall.

Prune spring blooming shrubs, vines, trees.

Applying mulch will deter weeds. Cedar mulch also helps repel pests like mosquitoes.
