PROTECTING YOUR FOUNDATION IN DRY WATHER

- Water the ground around your foundation evenly and regularly during dry weather.
- Lay a soaker hose around the perimeter of your home and water for several hours every day.
- Avoid letting the soil around your house completely dry out and shrink during a long dry spell.
- Run soaker 6 inches from foundation and 3 inches under soil.
