As a private, gated community, Montgomery County will not pick up our storm debris under the general county pickup. We are responsible for maintaining our own community and yards.

Working together and helping your neighbor will enable us to get back to our normal beauty as soon as possible.

debris in Common Areas

The POA has a tree service to dispose of these items.

- The Common Areas Committee will count the limbs to be cleared so that we can budget accurately.
- **DO NOT DRAG YOUR OWN LARGE LIMBS AND TREE STUMPS TO COMMON AREAS** as it will exceed the budget, and may affect the actual pickup.

small limbs and debris in your yard

Our waste provider will pick this up on our regularly scheduled Large Trash Day (currently the 4th Wednesday of the month), under the following guidelines:

- They will collect up to 25 bundles of yard waste per yard.
- Limbs must be less than 4 inch in diameter, less than 4 feet in length and tied in bunches weighing less than 50 pounds.
- Just raw material please. No bagged leaves or branches because they have to open and separate them.

large limbs, felled trees and other debris in your yard

Homeowners are responsible for cleaning out their own yards.

- Contract a tree service to remove the debris from your private property
- Whenever possible, the POA will arrange a dumpster that you can use to dispose of debris. You will have to transport it to this location, but there will be no charge to the homeowner.
- Just raw material please. No bagged leaves or branches because they have to open and separate them.
