

Biography for Wesley Bolinger – candidate for POA board – Point Aquarius

I have been a resident of this community for nearly six years. I was elected to fill a one-year term on the current board and am now up for election for a full term. I have served as the Treasurer for the current board during this last year.

I was appointed to fill a vacant position in a previous POA and then re-elected to two terms after that.

I served for 22 years in the military as an NCO, have been a Senior Vice President of a financial services company working in five states, owned and/or operated a farm and ranch operation for the majority of my life, and have raised a large family. I am currently the managing director of a family cemetery in Polk County.

My BA degree is in accounting. I have been a building contractor, inspector and appraiser. I was appointed as an officer of the court as a CASA.

During my military service I was the manager of the National Guard facilities in Colorado which contained over 1 million square feet of building space, several armories, training and maintenance facilities and a headquarters building. This service also included inspecting facilities, supervising construction of new buildings as well as major improvements, and purchasing new facilities. I was a career counselor and recruiter for over 10 years during which I placed over 1500 people into the military.

Five of our sons and two of our sons-in-law have served or are currently serving in the military. Two sons were appointed to military academies. All have been deployed at least once, with one scheduled to deploy in a couple weeks.

I am seeking a full term on the board this election cycle. I believe I have shown that I can help with the issues currently facing this community. Our current board is functioning very well, and I hope to continue to be a part of that.
